


How to Add Captioning to your ScreenPal Videos

(2) Click on the 'add' icon for "Captions".

Choose "Speech-to-Text" and then "Start":




(3) ScreenPal will generate the captions for you. You can double-click the text to edit it or you can choose "OK" to accept the generated captions.

***NOTE**: Don't press "OK" until all the captions are generated - if your video is long, it might take a while.
