

## **Cosmetology Program Application**

Thank you for your interest in the Helena College Cosmetology Program! The following information is important for determining eligibility and admission to the available spots in our program. Please ensure that all required information is submitted, as completion of certain items may earn you extra points in the application process.

All applications will undergo a comprehensive review, and rankings will be assigned based on the criteria outlined below. The top 16 applicants, as per the ranking, will be considered for admission to the program each fall and spring semester. Applicants will be notified with information about their applications after the review process has been completed. Applicants selected for admission must meet with the Cosmetology Instructors before receiving official admission to the program. The top ranked applicants will proceed to a final interview. Those with alternate status will be contacted if spots become available within the first week of the semester. If selected as an alternate, admission to the program is guaranteed in a future semester, provided all application and eligibility requirements are met. In the event of a tie in ranking, the application will be reviewed based on additional criteria. Consideration will be given to the applicant's status as a current or former student or alum of Helena College. Furthermore, the GPA for the five General Education courses (BGEN 105, COLS 101, COMX 115, M 105, and WRIT 122) will be considered.
