Helena College Pathways

Pathways Optimize Dual Enrollment

Helena College Pathways co-ordinate with Montana Career Pathways, published on the Montana University System website (MUS.edu). To support those statewide pathways, Helena College Pathways:

- Highlight programs within a pathway that are available at the local twoyear college.
- Show students how many dual enrollment credits they can potentially earn in each specific program.
- Guide high school students into the dual enrollment courses that will satisfy program requirements.
- Allow students to compare employment data, careers, work-based learning, high school courses, and dual credit options across programs.

During the 2018 Fall Semester, students enrolled in 47 different Helena College courses for Dual Credit. This totaled 821 enrollments! Although most students took the courses in their high schools, 11 took courses online and 25 took them on the Helena College campus.

By strategically selecting the most beneficial high school courses and learning opportunities, pathways help students move seamlessly from high school to college. When students begin focusing on a career pathway early, they learn whether or not they have the interest and skills to invest in that pathway.

Pathways list the dual enrollment courses by college program, so that students select courses that will apply to the degrees they wish to pursue.

The Helena College Pathways program also provides workshops for high school teachers and career exploration activities for students.
