I. Call to Order

Phillip called the meeting to order at 1:48 p.m.

II. Review of Minutes from Wednesday, August 27, 2025

Laura moved to approve the minutes as read from 8/27/25, Tod seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

III. New Business:

A. Curriculum Changes (Inactivate)

a. MUSI 101 & MUSI 203

We do not offer these courses anymore. There has been a major decrease in student participation in these courses, and they are not currently needed.

Phillip proposed to bundle these 2 courses since they have the same justifications.

Tod moved to approve the bundle of these two courses, Amy seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

Tod moved to approve the inactivation of MUSCI 101 & 203, Amy seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

b. WRIT 104



We have not offered this course in many years. COMX 106 is the new course that matches many of the outcomes from WRIT 104. It is not needed after making the changes.

Tod moved to approve the inactivation of WRIT 104, Keri seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

c. DDSN 135

A new course was created to cover the outcomes of this course, so this one no longer runs. They will keep the new course made in the program and pathways.

Laura moved to approve the inactivation of DDSN 135, Keri seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

d. MCH 120, 200, 279

Phillip proposed to bundle the three courses together. Keri moved to approve the bundle of these 3 MCH courses, Tod seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

These three courses are no longer offered and do not affect any current pathways.

Amy moved to approve the inactivation of MCH 120, 200, 279, Laura seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

e. WLDG 101

This course has not been offered or ran in a few years. The welding course was for Dual Enrollment, but no one was taking it. They now offer a different course to DE students if they are interested in welding.

Keri moved to approve the inactivation of WLDG 101, Laura seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

B. Curriculum Changes (Revisions)

a. ARTZ 102

Removed some of the outcomes [there were 20 total] and 3 FLOC outcomes. This will go into effect in Spring 2026.

Tod moved to approve the revision of ARTZ 102, Keri seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

b. SW 100

The removal of a Gen Ed Core box, no other changes made. It was never a core course.

Laura moved to approve the revision of SW 100, Tod seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

c. EDU 231

The removal of a Gen Ed Core box, no other changes made. It was never a core course.

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Tod moved to approve the revision of EDU 231, Keri seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, none abstained: motion carried.

C. Bundle CTE course revisions by program

All of these courses have changes in their co-req and pre-req language. This is a clean-up project for all of these courses. The co-req language also covers the COMX and Math courses required in all of the trade programs.
