### Finishing Trades (FTIUM) (SB)

- HC has a partnership with FTIUM. The legislature allocated 550K to the commissioners' office to allow FTIUM to come into Montana.
- FTIUM offers training in four skilled trades; paint, glazier, drywall, and glasswork. The program is apprenticeship based and employer led. Not a lot of employers in Montana have signed up to participate in the program.
- The commissioner's office has been holding the funds and has asked HC to identify projects to start using the allocation.
  - o The projects must directly support the FTIUM skilled training program.
    - Create a curriculum.
      - HC is building a pathway to capture the credits for each outcome in their field and identify the Gen Ed requirements so the student will receive an AAS degree.
    - Four Smart rooms on the APC. One will be the APC Lecture Hall.
      - Acoustics, paint, and floor finished in the APC.
      - Three other classrooms will be converted also.
    - Marketing and Promotional Campaign
      - Both HC and FTIUM will benefit.

## Mental Health Summit (ES)

- Three students from HC attended the Mental Health Summit in Billings which overlapped with the BOR meeting at MSU-Billings.
- Main Takeaway: Integrate student wellbeing into every aspect of curriculum and student life at HC.
  - o Faculty, staff, curriculum, student experience.
- UM Affiliates are working together to resource share with the smaller institutions.
- HC has the following trainings available to faculty and staff:
  - Kognito is a virtual, interactive mental health training to help recognize the signs of mental health issues, distress, suicide and how to communicate with and refer at-risk students.
    - Six faculty/staff have activated an account and two completed Kognito at HC.
    - Two students have activated an account, but have not completed the training.
    - Kognito will be available for 18 more months.
    - Nursing will look at adding it into a course.
  - o **QPR**: Question, Persuade, Refer
    - Suicide Prevention Gate Keeper training.
  - Safe College: Fosters a safer and more inclusive campus community.

#### LLH

- Understaffed and working on hiring a temporary library assistant.
- If the LLH has to be closed, messaging will be provided to the students. All of the services provided by the LLH are online.

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
