Mastermind Discussion:

Cari Schwen: Budget Update

- Cari Schwen presented the Q3 Financial Snapshot
 - Current Unrestricted Budget to Actual highlights:
 - Spring revenue is \$29K over the projected revenue.
 - Due to the change in how the summer revenue is calculated, HC was preparing to cover a 50K shortfall. Since the spring revenue is more than expected plus other savings, HC will have to cover only \$17,700.
 - o Restricted Budget to Actual
 - If Facilities spend over their budget, Cari transfers funds to cover the excess.
 - Mandatory Fee Recommendations
 - The Technology 2.5 fee will be \$24 and not part of the 3% increase.
 - The recommendations were approved by the ASHC. Final approval by the BOR.
 - FY26 Revenue Projections
 - Cari projected the following scenarios
 - 3% increase in tuition with no change in appropriation = \$8,483,777.63
 - 0% increase in tuition with no change in appropriation = \$8,424,177.33
 - o The difference of \$59,600.30
 - HC will receive \$253,124.36 for MUS 12Free initiative.
- Concerns:
 - Tariffs
 - o Enrollment impacts from federal changes.
 - Banner cost. FY26 cost will be \$355,115. Current funding will be \$250,000.
