# **Agenda Items**

# **Review Area Goals:**

- -Steve discussed the Quality of Work Life committee
  - -Could not find a way that his committee impacts student success
  - -Difficulty getting the committee goals to fit into the Institutional Assessment Template
- -The group discussed committee goals and how they relate the Institutional Goals and UMH Mission Statement
- -Dean Bingham asked the group if it is necessary that every committee have goals that fit into the template
  - -Our Mission Statement should encompass all aspects of the institution
  - -Revision of the Mission Statement should alleviate the issue
  - -All Committees should support the Institution
  - -Growth has changed what our Mission Statement and Strategic Plan should be
- -Steve said that after today's discussion he should be able to fit his committee goals in the template
  - -The Institutional Assessment Template will evolve with the Institution
- -Dean Bingham asked the group how each committee came up with their strengths and weaknesses:
  - -Budget Committee is not yet to that point
  - -Faculty is setting up a blog
  - -Facility & Safety will send the template to committee members for input
  - -The group discussed the assessment process for Department's and Committee's
- -Dean Bingham asked that each committee utilize the Institutional Assessment Template throughout the year to establish their committee and departmental goals

#### **ACTION ITEM:**

- -Committees will complete items 1-3 on the Institutional Assessment Template and throughout the year complete 4; at the end of the year assess 5
- -The group agreed to have a standing agenda item of "Institutional Committee Goals and Mission Statement Review"

## **Committee Minutes:**

- -Art discussed committee's sending their minutes to faculty as faculty is too busy to search for each set of minutes; if minutes were sent to their email they would be more easily read
- -The group discussed taking the responsibility of going to website and reviewing committee minutes
  - -Janice mentioned that she does read the Leadership minutes because Winnie emails them
- -Dean Bingham asked that if each Committee Chair would like to email the minutes to everyone it is up to them

## Core Themes:

- -Sarah handed out the new framework for the Accreditation Standards
- -Core Themes are basically our Mission Statement parsed out into smaller parts
- -Recommend 5-7 Core Themes
- -Come up with the Mission Statement and break in down into Core Themes
- -Values should permeate a majority of our core themes
- -The group discussed the framework of Accreditation Standards and its impact on our Mission Statement, Strategic Plan and Goals
  - -Develop the Mission Statement
  - -Pull Core Themes
  - -Strategic Plan
  - -Break it down into measureable goals
  - -The group discussed the process of coming up with our new Mission Statement

- -Setup a Task Force to develop the process of drafting a Mission Statement that includes the external and internal community
- -Task Force members are: Dean Bingham, Brandi Foster, Kevin Brockbank, Winnie Strainer, Sarah Dellwo, Barb McAlmond, Steve Lewis; a faculty member, student representative, Staff Senate member, Local Executive Advisory Board member
  - -Members to be discussed at next Council meeting and first meeting date to be determined

## **Service to Community:**

- -Dean Bingham discussed the trip to Lincoln that he, Brandi, and Jeff made on 10-05-09
- -Adopt the School
  - -IT Services
  - -Library
  - -Opportunities for Continuing Ed
- -Great opportunity for us to make a difference in a local public school
- -The High School and Elementary School are combined

- -78 Students
- Jeff briefly assessed their IT infrastructure
  - -Discussed IT options that would help the school
  - -No security whatsoever on their system
  - -We could help with services management
- -Dean Bingham asked the group if they are interested in the project
- -Group consensus is that this is worth pursuing

# Fall Enrollment:

- -Mike Brown reviewed the Fall 2009 Enrollment Summary
- -What does the increased enrollment mean to each Department and Committee
  - -Long term and short term decision-making
- -Russ reviewed FTE comparisons with other institutions and their funding dollars from the State
- -40% of current growth is due to the current economy
- -How do we project/plan our budgets based on future FTE numbers
  - -Can we maintain these numbers?
  - -What if numbers drop?
- -BOR was notified during the September 09 meeting that we are dealing with the same amount of resources and a large increase in FTE

## H1N1 Plan:

- -The Plan will be on the UMH website; a page dedicated to H1N1
- -Largest part of the Plan is prevention
- -MUS has asked us to report how many staff, faculty, and students have flu-like symptoms
- -The group discussed if we should cancel 2 large events the college has this month; Griz Party and the Haunted Airplane
- -The group consensus was to proceed with the events but make adjustments ie; no self-serve nacho bar, etc.

# Campus Security:

- -There have been discussions with UM re: security options
- -More information will be more information available soon
