New Business:

- Wellness grant for Holiday Cheer activities for the campus was awarded
- December 13th: Ornament Exchange
 - Melanie will oversee this activity
 - Melanie will look to book a room for this event
 - This is a "white elephant" style event where you bring a wrapped or gift bagged ornament, get a number, and then pick a gift in order. Each ornament can be "stolen" up to two times
- December 20th: Breakfast before the State of the College meeting
 - Planning for 100
 - Cari will order food from Sysco
 - Food planning: scrambled eggs, diced potatoes, flank steak (Rick to help prepare), biscuits, gravy (Phil to make his SECRET sausage gravy for 100! (2), tortillas, fruit, pastries, drip coffee, salsa and cheese.
 - If you have other ideas or requests, send a message to Cari BEFORE Dec 12th which is when she is placing the order
- December 22nd: Cookie Exchange
 - Mary and Cari will oversee this activity
 - Melanie will help reserve a room for this event
 - Plan: staff sign up, and then bring a single cookie or treat in amounts enough to serve 2 per participant. For example, if 35 people sign up, you would bring 6 dozen of your chosen treat. Everyone then gets to take home a variety of treats!
 - Cari will bring table cloths for the tables in the room
- Additional Events:
