Joshua Schwerin is a rising senior at Bozeman High school in Bozeman, Montana, who's passion has been flying from a very young age. Josh began flying at 15 years old, soloed in an airplane on his 16th birthday, and on August 3rd, 2024 became the youngest person to break the Guinness World Record for circumnavigate the Contiguous United States by aircraft at 17 years old!

In preparation for his record-breaking attempt, Joshua created the Fly Beyond Boundaries Scholarship Fund in hopes to help fellow students who share in his aviation passion. His Fly Beyond Boundaries scholarship has raised enough funds to award two students a full ride scholarship to the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program at Helena College!

The Fly Beyond Boundaries Scholarship is graciously offering two full ride scholarships to two students who have graduated from a high school in Montana, have been accepted into the upcoming Fall 2025 Helena College Aviation Maintenance Technology Program, attending as a full-time student, and are in good academic standing. Students who have been awarded these scholarship funds will need to maintain a good academic standing during the entirety of the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program, and complete the program in the standard 5 semester time frame from August 2025 to May 2027.

Deadline: May 30th, 2025 at 5pm

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduated from a High School in Montana
- Enrolled in the Aviation Maintenance Technology program at Helena College
- Full-time student
- In good academic standing with at least a 2.0 GPA and meeting a 70% SAP passage rate.

Application Procedure & Criteria:

1. Complete the application form and return it to the Financial Aid Office on or before the deadline.
2. Complete a 1-2-page essay explaining your educational and future career goals, how these relate to your passion for aviation, and how this scholarship would help you achieve these goals.
3. Attach one letter of recommendation.
4. A copy of your unofficial transcripts.

Selection Decision:

The Schwerin family will review all applications and notify Helena College, who will then award the scholarship funds on their behalf. Each scholarship recipient will write an acknowledgement letter (thank you) to the Schwerin family.
