

## Panorama Accessibility Flags Issue:

### Decorative Images Flagged as Missing Alt Text

#### Root Cause:

- Canvas marks decorative images using alt="", but Panorama requires either alt="null" or role="presentation" to correctly recognize a decorative image.
- The role="presentation" attribute is only added when the decorative setting is toggled off and then back on.

#### Faculty Workaround:

If you encounter an image flagged by Panorama as missing alt text (even though it is marked decorative), follow these steps:

#### Steps to Correct Decorative Image Marking in Canvas

1. **Open the Canvas Content:**
  - Navigate to the Canvas page (or assignment/discussion) where the image is embedded.
2. **Edit the Page:**
  - Click the **Edit** button (upper-right corner) to open the content editor.
3. **Select the Image:**
  - Click on the image that should be marked as decorative.
4. **Access Image Options:**
  - In the floating toolbar that appears, click **Image Options**.
5. **Toggle the Decorative Image Setting:**
  - Uncheck the **Decorative Image** box.
  - Then, recheck the **Decorative Image** box.
  - This forces Canvas to add the correct HTML attribute (role="presentation").
6. **Finish Editing:**
  - Click **Done** to apply the change.
  - Scroll down and click **Save** to publish your changes.
7. **(Optional) Verify the HTML:**
  - Open the HTML Editor (via the three-dot menu "</> HTML Editor") to check that the image tag now includes:  
alt="" role="presentation"
