Welcome to Helena College and to Moodle, our virtual campus! We are excited to have you. Students often have many questions about Moodle, so here is a list of frequently asked questions to get you started.

	Answer
Can I use Internet Explorer, Safari, or Chrome?	No. You need to use Mozilla Firefox. You can download Mozilla at <u>http://www.mozilla.org/en-US/products/</u> . It is a free download.
When are my courses available?	The first day of the semester. However, the <u>Moodle Tutorial for</u> <u>Students</u> course will be available to you the week prior.
Where do I login?	Go to <u>www.HelenaCollege.edu</u> and click on ' Portals ' in the top gray bar. Choose " Student Portal ". Then click on the " Moodle " icon.

How do I login?	At the login page, click on Net ID and then enter your Net ID and password. If you are a new student , you'll need to activate your NetID . You can do that here: <u>https://user.helenacollege.edu/activate</u> .
