Pathway Advising Notes: This pathway is perfect for students who aren't fully decided on their career course just yet. It has a strong base in both the humanities and the sciences. The pathway leads to a BS in Interdisciplinary Arts & Sciences, and students can choose to either receive an AA or an AS from Helena College.

The part-time pathway is designed for three years, using two summer terms.

Course Advising Notes: WRIT101 or WRIT121: Both WRIT 101 and WRIT 121 satisfy this written communications requirement. The choice should be made based upon the student's interests

CHMY121: This course is the first in the science sequence and sets up students for their future biology courses.

M121: Foundational math class.

ENST230: 200 level course / Recommended for pathway - intersection of science and humanities

SPNS101: Additional humanities / fine arts + foreign language, Diversity

STAT216: Satisfies second math requirement for Tech, 200 level course

BIOB160: Continued foundation in science. This course should be taken after CHMY 121 and before BIOB 170.

LIT211: Diversity, CHAI, 200 level course

PSYX100: Building foundation in social sciences.

BIOB170: Continued foundation in science. This course should be taken after CHMY 121 and BIOB 160.

COMX111: COMX 111 is required for Tech. COMX 115 will not satisfy this requirement.

PHL110: Recommended for pathway / broader understanding of humanities

PSYX120: Recommended for pathway - building base in research

SOCI101: Foundational course in humanities.

SPNS102: Additional humanities / fine arts, 200 level course

SOCI201: 200 level course / Recommended for pathway

WRIT201: Continued foundation in written communication / 200-level course

HONR121: Recommended for pathway / broader understanding of humanities
